We want to give an update of how the ReConnect project is going in Coosawattee.

Good news, we had a great month in Coosawattee. It now looks like we will finish up Phase 1 either sometime later this month or early January. Phase 2 installs will begin before our goal of February unless we hit a snag.

We are adjusting to changes out of our control to get fiber service installed as quickly as possible. Our goal continues to be to get fiber installed to our ReConnect area well before the deadline of December 2024.

We appreciate all the kind words and encouragement we have received during this project. We are in it together and ask for patience and understanding as we do our best to get fiber built.

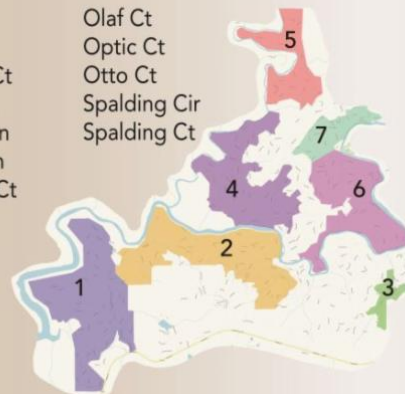

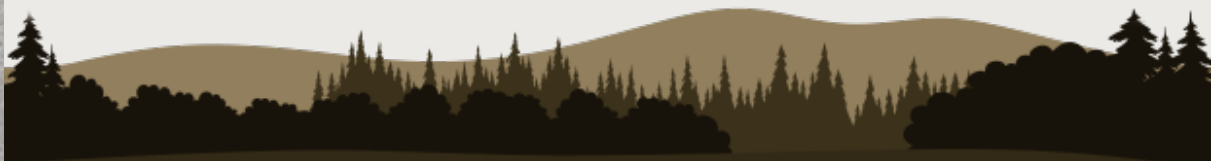
