Happy stormy Friday CRR!

The annual election is in full swing, and we've received a number of inquiries about how lot numbers appear on some ballots. Due to the character formatting used by Association Voting, some lot numbers were truncated and may be missing a numeric character at the beginning, or may be missing an "R" at the end in case of replatted lots. This will not affect your vote. If you are voting online, be sure to enter your lot number exactly as it appears on the mailing from Association Voting including capital letters, dashes, zeros, etc. Your password is also case sensitive, so be sure to enter that exactly as shown as well.

The Nominating Committee wanted us to let you know that they will be meeting in the Fireplace Room at the POA this coming Wednesday, the 14th from 2:00-3:00PM. Also, we will have PCs available in the POA library and will offer online voting assistance for anyone who wants or needs it on July 16th, 19th, and 20th from 2:00-4:00PM.

Also, we've had a number of requests for bios on candidates who didn't attend or submit material for the recent meet and greet, and also didn't choose to send out a mailing to their constituents or engage in other forms of campaigning. We've requested the candidates submit something we can distribute, but we can only share what we receive. Anything we receive will be available for pickup at the POA beginning

Monday afternoon upon request.

The meeting of the Nominating Committee on Wednesday will be in person only which brings me to one other thing I want to mention very briefly.

We're actively working on implementing a video conferencing solution at the Water Tower to allow the Board and Committees to meet in person as desired, while maintaining the option for residents to continue to attend via Zoom as has been the recent practice. A Message From Your Environmental Conservation Committee

The Coosawatee Environmental Conservation Committee would like to encourage property owners to use plants native to Georgia in their landscaping and to control/remove invasive species. The Georgia Exotic Pest Plant Council (GAEPPC) maintains a list of non-native plants ranked by categories of potential harm. The list can be found here:

Native habitats in our community will encourage more wildlife and prevent erosion after storms – please do your part to make our community beautiful!

Also, according to the UGA Extension service, ticks transmit diseases such as Rocky Mountain Spotted Fever and Lyme disease. Although rare, Tularemia, Anaplasmosis, Human Ehrlichiosis and Southern Tick-Associated Rash Illness (STARI) can be transmitted through a tick bite. It usually

takes at least 36 hours for a tick to transmit the bacteria that causes Lyme disease. Try to avoid moist brushy areas, particularly if browsed by deer. If you do find yourself in vegetation that brushes against your body, do a tick check! Remove an embedded tick with tweezers or paper towel positioned as close to the point of attachment as possible; pull outward firmly. Clean with disinfectant. If mouthparts remain under the skin, infection can result.
