Protecting our Homes from the Threat of Wildfires

Much has been in the news about wildfires across the US, especially last year. Although the threat of wildfire is always present, drought conditions and increased human activity in forested lands has increased the risk of fire. According to the National Interagency Fire Center (NIFC) statistical reporting for 2020, nationally there were 58,950 wildfires reported in 2020, compared to 50,477 wildfires reported in 2019. Indeed, the 2020 fire season was historical in both the total number of acres nationally burned (10,122,336 acres) and the total number of acres burned in one fire (over one million acres) at the August Complex in northern

California. Here in Georgia, last year 3,154 fires burned 12,407 acres. Clearly, there is a need for homeowners in Coosawattee to consider protecting our homes from wildfire threat.

For fire to burn, it needs fuel, oxygen, and an ignition spark. Of these three items, fuel and spark are the easiest to control. To this end, the National Fire Protection Agency (NFPA) recommends removal of all flammable materials within five feet of your house. These items might include equipment such as lawnmowers, oil, gas, or paint cans, propane tanks, gasoline powered tools or firewood stacks, pine needles in gutters, mulch, or dead overhanging branches. To prevent creating sparks, avoid mowing over rocky ground or using a weed eater in areas with dry brush and hidden rocks. To further prevent fire spread, create fuel breaks by hardscaping driveways, walkways, and patio garden spaces. If possible, consider removing or trimming all mature trees within ten feet of your roofline as well as installing a metal roof. Implementation of any of these suggestions will lower the risk of wildfire damaging not only your home but also the homes around you.
