Note From the General Manager's Office

Greetings,

As mentioned in the recent text alert, the construction on Newport is nearly finished, but the area will be gravel until it can be paved so exercise a little extra caution there. The Nexus area will also be undergoing paving very soon. The work on Pacer Ct. is scheduled to begin soon as well. The section that will be closed is between 180 Pacer Ct. and 470 Pacer Ct., so be mindful of that if it will impact your travels.

In addition to the above-mentioned road work, we are also planning paving for 10th street and Water Oak. We will send out more details on timeline and scope soon.

If you recall, earlier in the year we mentioned that we had ordered new playground equipment for Fish Trap Park. Having ordered this equipment all the way back in May, we're excited to let you know that we're finally about to take delivery and the install is scheduled to begin soon. If you're in the area during the early part of next week you'll see the grading work getting under way to prepare the site. We'll do our best to keep you updated as to progress with photos while the work is ongoing.

Our goal with these types of projects is to "spread the wealth" throughout the community as much as we can. We try to choose projects that will benefit and impact as many as possible and plan them across the community.

In addition to the projects going on throughout the community, did you know that you have another benefit of living in Coosawattee?... Access to the multiple parks and Villas in CRRRA are another, of several amenities, offered to residents. The Parks are a beautiful retreat that are reserved for residents and guests of the resort. In addition to having access to the recreational enjoyment of 5 parks in your "backyard", residents (and their guests) may reserve camping spaces for overnight camping at several of the parks. Where this was offered to outside guests in the past, it is only available for residents (and their guests). We also rent out multiple Villas, and they are available to residents and their guests at a 50% discounted rate. We encourage you to call the Reservations office and take advantage of all the wonderful things that being a resident of Coosawattee has to offer.

Another Coosawattee gem are the events! We hope that you were able to attend the Halloween spectacular at the Stables. Due to the success of Trunk or Treat at the Stables at Coosawattee (which made the paper!) we're already busy planning a special Christmas event at the same location. Details will be forthcoming as plans move further along, but we did want to give you a heads up that this will definitely be happening and we'll be announcing a date and time soon.

Lastly, as a reminder from last week, we are supporting Toys for Tots again this year and have collection boxes placed at both the POA and the Rec Center for any donations you may be able to graciously give.

Gilmer County's three recycling centers can be found at 4154 Hwy 52 E, 456 Tower Road, and the Coosawattee Convenience Center at 1738 Hwy 382 East.

There is no charge for recyclables of paper, cardboard, clean aluminum beverage cans or plastic. All other forms of household trash are accepted for a small fee. Styrofoam cannot be recycled but can be added to regular trash.

In addition to all of the above, glass can also be recycled at the Pickens County Recycling Center, 390 Appalachian Ct. in Jasper.

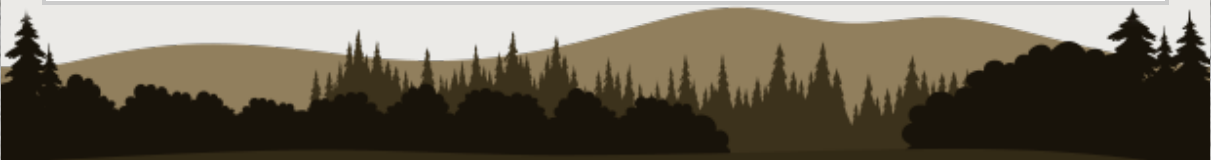
